Professor Faizel Osman was appointed in 2008 at UHCW to set up and lead the Cardiac Rhythm Management (EP and Devices) service. He was appointed honorary Professor of Cardiology in 2018 with the University of Warwick (Warwick Medical School) and Coventry University (Centre for Health & Life Sciences) and appointed Director of the Institute for Cardio-Metabolic Medicine in 2023. He has several research interests in the field of arrhythmia, including sudden cardiac death risk prediction, atrial fibrillation, cardiac autonomic function, sleep apnoea, and hypertrophic cardiomyopathy; the latter also involves collaborations with academics at the University of Warwick. He has published extensively in the field of arrhythmia and has successfully supervised five PhD cardiology research fellows. He has been awarded several large research grants from the British Heart Foundation, Medtronic Ltd, Abbott Medical, Boston Scientific and Bristol Myers Squibb. He has presented in the field of arrhythmia at both national and international meetings.
